Harlow has a rich cultural scene and is the UK's only sculpture town with **over 100 public sculptures on display**. The town's history and artistic flare is celebrated at many of the local attractions.

Performing arts are showcased at the **Harlow Playhouse, Victoria Hall Theatre** and **Moot House**.










For leisure activities Harlow has much to offer, from **Harlow Museum, shops** and **galleries**, to **family days out**. Plus, there are two cinemas, a bowling alley, escape rooms, splash parks, a skate park, a specialist climbing and paddle-sport centre and the **Town Park**, with a paddling pool and two play areas, one of which is accessible.
